## **Kimmage Manor Church**

We hope that our parishioners and visitors are enjoying the **August sunshine**. During this **month of August**, the following **initiatives** are taking place in the parish church:

We are **trying to free up space in many** areas of the church, as we are coming under increasing pressure for storing a variety of items. Many of the items that are stored in different areas of the church are no longer used in our parish. We have completed the cleaning the Storeroom beside the Sacristy and the Kitchen. The Sacristy and its adjoining room are being tackled now, while the large Storeroom at the back of the Parish Hall is being studied. The amount of non-essential items that are being disposed of is incredible.

The Ethiopian Orthodox Church have been using our church twice monthly on Saturdays and have been doing so for the last 3 years. The Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church (Indian Orthodox Church) have also recently made an application to use our church on Sundays from 1.30 - 7pm. It is important to communicate that both

groups use the church at a time when it is not used or needed by any other parish group. Both groups pay for the use of the church, and bills must be paid! Our welcome to the above Christian Churches is also a huge sign in the promotion of Unity between our churches (ecumenism), with Jesus Christ at its foundation.
