Faith & Liturgy

Advent is a season of four weeks leading up to Christmas that involves hopeful anticipation for Christ's birth, and also reflection on his second coming. It is a time for spiritual preparation through prayer and reflection, focusing on the "three comings" of Christ: his historical birth, his present coming in the sacraments, and his future second

The origin of the Advent Wreath and candles can be traced back to pre-Christian Germanic cultures who would light candles during the winter solstice to honour the return of the light. This practice was adopted by Christians in the Middle Ages as a way to mark the season of Advent.

The circular shape of the wreath represents eternity, reminding us of God's infinite love and presence in our lives. The greenery used to decorate it symbolizes everlasting life and hope given to us by Jesus. The wreath's significance is further highlighted by the lighting of the candles sequentially each week, which provides us with a tangible way to mark the passing of time and encourages us to reflect on the themes of hope, peace, joy and love.

The **New Church Year begins** this weekend with the 1st Sunday of Advent, Year A.
