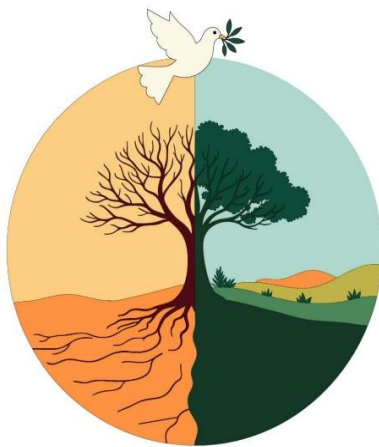

## SEASON OF CREATION 2025

September 1<sup>st</sup> – October 4<sup>th</sup>. feast of St. Francis of Assisi



**Theme: 'Peace with Creation'** inspired by Isaiah 32:14-18

*'My people will abide in a peaceful habitation, in secure dwellings, and in quiet resting places'.* In a world of great suffering, marked by war, suffering, climate change and global instability, how can we work towards peace with creation?

The Season of Creation is celebrated throughout the Christian world from 1 September to 4 October. During this time, we savour the precious gift of creation whilst heeding the call to protect, respect, repair and to walk more gently on Mother Earth. Each of us can do this through reducing our use of water and energy, and importantly limit our purchase of goods to what we need rather to what we want!
