The Pollinator Patch

You might have wondered how the 'Pollinator Patch' in front of the Church door did this year, so here's a brief update. The Yellow Rattle that underpins the patch did quite well – it starves the grass of nutrients and creates space for other plants to grow. We also saw (deep breath) Love-in-a-mist, Lesser knapweed, Culvers Root, Hairy Willowherb and Foxglove make an appearance. The large seed-heads at the rear of the patch are Teasel and their heads provide lots of food for small birds, especially goldfinches. We'll cut the patch back in late October, 'roughen it up' and plant some added seeds that will probably lie dormant until Spring. Perhaps you too created a small 'patch for wildlife' in your own garden this year, and if so we hope it gave you lots of pleasant surprises as the year progressed. Every little helps when it comes to Nature.

Season of Creation workshops:

The Kimmage Manor Environmental group are pleased to confirm that we will be hosting a workshop on Climate Change on the night of <u>Tuesday September 30th</u> at 7pm in the Parish Hall in Kimmage.

The workshop is titled 'An Introduction to Climate Change and what local communities can do to address it' and will be led/facilitated by Niamh Brennan of Global Action Plan (GAP). This is an Irish NGO that is focused on helping us all understand what we can do as individuals to work

for Climate Justice, and to do what we can to 'help the planet' as outlined in Pope Francis' encyclical Laudato Si. You can find out more about what Global Action Plan do at globalactionplan.ie

The night will be an interactive discussion and workshop with participation actively encouraged. The intention is to have a second such workshop in late October (Tuesday 28th) to follow up on the themes discussed..
