On **Tuesday February 24th** at 1pm, Trócaire's CEO, Seán Farrell, will be speaking on "Rising to the Challenge: Confronting Poverty and Injustice in Our Time". We will reflect on this year's Lenten Campaign which focuses on Rwanda, have time for reflection and Q&A. Everyone is welcome.

On **Tuesday March 3rd** at 7pm, the St. Patrick's College Maynooth, Annual Trócaire Lent Lecture takes place and is available to attend in person or online. This year's speaker is Dr. Hugo Slim, University of Oxford and the title of the lecture is "Caring for Creation Amidst the Cries of War ~ Working for Peace in the Earth Community".
