Faith & Liturgy

This weekend the **Malankara Orthodox Syrian (Indian Orthodox) Church** will commence worshipping in our parish church. They will worship from about 1.30-7pm on Sundays. We welcome them. This Christian church traces its origins to the Apostle St. Thomas in the 1st century. It is a major part of India's ancient St. Thomas Christian community and is headquartered in Kerala, India. The church is autocephalous, meaning it is self-governing, and follows the ancient West Syrian liturgical rite. We welcome them.

November is traditionally a month for remembering and praying for the dead, a tradition rooted in Christian observances like All Saint's Day (Nov 1st) & All Souls' Day (Nov 2nd). Beyond religious services, many communities find ways to commemorate loved ones through specific rituals such as lighting candles, attending memorial services, writing down names, and creating remembrance shrines.

At the church's entrance parishioners & friends will be able to write the names of the loved ones and attach it to the November Tree. **On the Altar** there will be a smaller November Tree, highlighting those who have died in the last 12 months.

On the table at our church's entrance you will find a **November Envelope (altar list of the dead)**, inside it you will find a sheet of paper where you can write the names of your deceased loved ones and friends. This sheet will be left on the altar, and if you wish you can leave a donation.

Parish Church Fundraiser: Starting on the weekend of 22 & 23 November, we will be selling tickets after weekend Masses for hampers which will be raffled in the Parish Hall after the Carol Service which will take place on **Sunday, 14th December**.
